
ANNUAL MEETING

OLD BUSINESS

Gypsy Moths: Due to legal issues the Board was unable to follow through with collecting money for spraying as voted on by the membership. Members can have their properties sprayed as done in the past on a lot by lot basis. Members voted to rescind the decision made during the the 2016 annual meeting in regards to spraying.

FINANCIALS

The Financial Secretary, Wendy Robinson gave her report with an overview of our expenses with a handout. There were no questions so the financials were accepted. There are currently 16 lots which are delinquent.

ROADS

The Roads Chairman, Grover Cleveland, presented the roads report. The potholes will be filled by the end of June. Cedar, Maple, and Hemlock will be graded, crowned, and stoned. Next year, these roads will be tar and chipped, budget permitting. Pocono Spray Patch will repair the tar and chipped roads that are scraped and damaged. If the budget allows, they will put down a fog coat on the tar and chipped roads.

POOL

The pool report was presented by the Recreation/Pool Chairman, Mike Aleksich. The pool was officially open for member use June 24th. The hours will be 12-7 PM. Lifeguards have been hired and we will be paying them the same way we did last year. There is a Facebook page under Spruce Hill Farms Pool for updates on pool closures.
